- * Clearly serves as a role model for young women, both personally and professionally
- * ATHENA Young Professionals are 40 or younger
- * ATHENA Young Professionals may represent either the profit or not-for-profit sector
- * Previous ATHENA Young Professionals are not eligible for nomination; however, past nominees may be nominated again.

How to nominate an amazing leader:

- * It's easy! Just complete this nomination form!
- * **Here is the important part!** Personal testimonials and documented examples of leadership techniques and experiences are necessary and considered an important part of this nomination process. Include them...stories, examples, testimonials...they provide important context to the nomination!

The Selection Process:

- * We use the criteria provided by ATHENA International to select the award recipients.
- * **Nominees are kept confidential and only the award recipients will be made public** so that nominees not selected may be nominated again in future years! (Only one award per category is made each year.)
