



The Barry County Chamber and Economic Development Alliance will not endorse individual candidates running for public office but will advocate for legislation that affects the Barry County business committee based on the 5 elements of a vibrant economy:

THE 5 ELEMENTS OF A VIBRANT ECONOMY

- 1. A competitive business climate
 - ✓ A place to do business that is affordable, predictable, and provides incentives for growth
 - ✓ A place where small businesses are encouraged to start, thrive, and grow
 - ✓ A smart regulatory approach that balances the need for regulation and the need for private sector job growth
- 2. A robust private sector environment that works in partnership with the public sector to spur innovation and produce collective problem solving
- 3. Strategic process for recruiting new employers to locate in Barry County and strengthening existing businesses
- 4. Enhanced global-trade opportunities
- 5. Up-to-date transportation, public services, and communications infrastructure

CREATING A VIBRANT AND SUSTAINABLE ECONOMY

BCCEDA will support both the Executive and Legislative branches of County and State Government in creating a vibrant economy.





Population

Barry County is known for its' beautiful scenery and many outdoor opportunities. With 430 acres of recreational land, 1 State Game Area, 2 Trail Systems, 3 Canoe Liveries, 3 Recreational Facilities, 6 Golf Courses, 13 City & Village Parks, 23 Private Campgrounds with 1,661 available sites, 37 lakes, and 1 river, it's a stop you don't want to miss.

Barry County prides itself on providing a high quality of life that creates an ideal setting for any family or business that desires a rural backdrop and a natural landscape. It has been said that Barry County is on the way to everywhere, being only a short, 30-minute drive to all of West Michigan's urban areas including Battle Creek, Kalamazoo, Lansing and Grand Rapids.





Northwest River Corridor

Much more than just the gateway to the Grand Rapids area, Barry County's Northwest Corridor is the fastestgrowing part of the county, including the villages of Middleville, Freeport, Thornapple, and Irving Townships.

Downtown Middleville is seeing a resurgence as of late, welcoming multiple new restaurants. The Paul Henry Trail connects with the North Country Trail to the South. The Riverbank Music Series fills Friday evenings with live music throughout the summer months.

Freeport, situated at the intersection of Barry, Kent, and Ionia Counties, features a quaint downtown with rich history.

Lake Country

Find yourself amid the lakes in Barry County's Southwest region, including Hope, Barry, and Prarieville Townships. The small burgs of Delton, Hickory Corners, and Cloverdale - each with their own charm and unique local businesses - are nestled among rolling hills, rich farmland, and more bodies of water than you can imagine.

Destination lakes such as Wall, Long, and Crooked have been recreational havens for generations. The famous Gull Lake's northernmost point is in Barry County. Don't miss attractions such as the Gilmore Car Museum - voted #1 visitor attraction in Michigan - and Hop Head Farms, one of the leading hop farms in the Midwest! M-43 Highway weaves through this area, connecting Barry County to the Kalamazoo Metro Area.

Farms and Forests

The county's southwest quadrant is lush with some of Michigan's best agricultural, natural opportunities aplenty, and serves as the primary corridor to the Battle Creek metro area. The rural townships of Assyria, Baltimore, Johnstown, and Maple Grove provide wide-open spaces while still plenty close to amentities in larger nearby communities.

The world-class nature & educational center, Pierce Cedar Creek Institute, offers year-round activities for all ages, and a significant Amish population resides and works in this area. Continuing the trend in Barry County, this is also home to another couple dozen lakes, with many recreational opportunites available!

Route 66 Corridor

Michigan's own 'Route 66' includes this scenic stretch in Eastern Barry County, and along M-43 helps connect the Villages of Nashville and Woodland as well as Carlton, Castleton, and Woodland Townships.

The 'Nashville of the North' hosts family-friendly events in its historic downtown throughout the year, including a throwback outdoor music venue at the historic Sandyland property just outside of town.

Thornapple River and Lake provide plenty of water-centric opportunities for fun, as does Jordan Lake north of Woodland and Leach Lake north of Hastings. Don't miss the picturesque, historic Putnam District Library in Nashville or MOO-ville Creamery just outside town for the best ice cream anywhere!






Explore Barry County Parks!

Paul Henry - Thornapple Trail

The Paul Henry - Thornapple Trail is a multi-use recreation trail connecting with the North Country Trail. It includes paved sections that are perfect for family walks, biking, or training for your next 5k. It also features more rustic sections that offer opportunities for mountain biking, longer through-hikes, and birding. When complete, the trail will span an impressive forty-two miles from Grand Rapids to Vermontville!



Historic Charlton Park

Historic Charlton Park's Village, Museum, and recreation area have been fixtures of Barry County since 1936. Often referred to as "the Jewel of Barry County', this sprawling 310-acre park includes the picturesque Thornapple River, hiking trails, and a plethora of wildlife. Pavilions and modern restrooms provide modern amenities to visitors. Whether hiking, fishing, swimming, boating, birding or playing on the newly-added playgrounds, Historic Charlton Park has something for everyone!

McKeown Bridge Park

Located just off Nashville Road in Hastings, the impressive historic McKeown Bridge spans 119 feet across the Thornapple River. Originally built in 1903, the McKeown Road bridge was the last metal truss highway bridge built in Barry County and is now the focal point of the McKeown Bridge Park, a 23-acre park featuring a paved river walk, trails, fishing docks, covered picnic tables, pit restroom, and canoe & kayak launch. This idyllic park is perfect for picnics, pictures, and passing the time away!

Thornapple Birding Trail

Birding in Barry County is fun at any time of the year. In the spring, enjoy the warbler migration, which peaks around mid-May. Up to twenty different species of warblers can be seen in the county, including the beautiful yet elusive Cerulean Warbler. Woodland birding continues to delight throughout the summer, with sightings including Acadian Flycatchers, Hooded Warblers, Scarlet Tanagers, and Wild Turkeys. Fall brings the ever-impressive Sandhill Crane migration and even a chance to spot migrating Common Loons! Winter finches like juncos, American Tree Sparrows, and Snow Buntings provide continued fun as the landscape turns snowy and quiet.

The Thornapple Birding Trail Map and Guide makes it easy for visitors to enjoy the best of our many bird-filled habitats in over 22,000 acres of state game areas, numerous parks, and over 250 lakes. Enjoy tranquility, learning, and closeness to nature at any of the stops on the map. Each site offers safe, easy-to-access birding locations in high-quality habitats and peaceful settings. 


